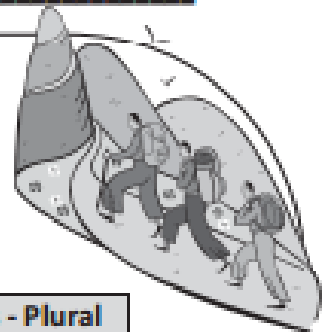


# Subject Pronouns

A subject pronoun is used as the subject of a sentence in place of a person's or thing's name or description, particularly after the subject has already been introduced.



Person	Subject Pronouns – Singular	Subject Pronouns - Plural
1 <sup>st</sup> (speaking)	<b>I</b>	<b>We</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup> (being spoken to)	<b>You</b>	<b>You</b>
3 <sup>rd</sup> (being spoken about)	<b>He/She/It</b>	<b>They</b>
