

Buckeye Lake Moose Lodge 2434 Scholarship

The Buckeye Lake Moose Lodge 2434 will be offering scholarship grants to this year high school senior. Scholarships may be used at any accredited college, trade, or technical school in which the student is enrolled full – time.

A committee representing the Buckeye Lake Moose Lodge 2434 will make the selection of the recipients. Applicants will be required to provide an essay to the committee of no more than one page, double-spaced, explaining their future plans and career goals and why they feel they should be selected for the scholarship.

1 Page Written Essay

The committee shall use their subjective judgment to determine scholarship winners. The committee's decision shall be final and not subject to appeal. In the event the recipient withdraws from school before attending classes, and money awarded by the Buckeye Lake Moose Lodge 2434 must be returned.

Buckeye Lake Moose Lodge 2434 Scholarship Guidelines

- 1) Must be a student at Millersport High School for the entire senior year.
- 2) Can be used at any accredited school.
- 3) The scholarships will be awarded to full-time students who have been accepted by a college or university, trade or technical school.
- 4) Money will be given directly to the student upon presentation by the student of a fee receipt for the school he / she is attending.
- 5) The scholarship is a grant, not a loan.
- 6) This scholarship is for one year only.
- 7) To be considered, the applications must be completed and turned in to the high school guidance counselor no later than January 15, 2016.
